

**EXPLANATION OF RIGHTS PURSUANT TO MARYLAND RULE 4-333(e)**

**YOU ARE HEREBY ADVISED THAT:**

1. A motion to vacate your conviction has been filed by the Baltimore City States Attorney's Office (BCSAO). The decision to vacate the conviction is to be decided by a judge.

2. You have the right to file a response to the motion. Pursuant to Md. Criminal Procedure 8-301.1, you have thirty (30) days from the date on the Certificate of Service to file your response with the Clerk of the Baltimore City Circuit/District Court. The number for the Circuit Court Clerk is 410-333-3733. The numbers for the District Court Clerks are:

3. You also have the right to request a hearing and attend the hearing. If you file a response, put in the response that you want a hearing and you want to attend the hearing. Make sure you provide the clerk with an updated valid address.

4. You have the right to seek assistance of a lawyer. If you cannot afford a lawyer, please contact the Office of the Public Defender. The number for the Circuit Court Office of the Public Defender is 410-333-4900. The numbers for the District Court Office of the Public Defenders are:
